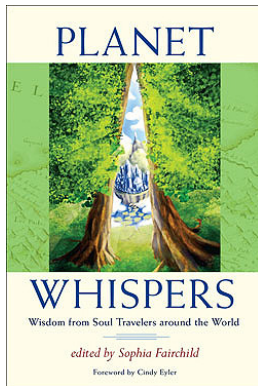

SWP: What brings you the greatest joy in life?
