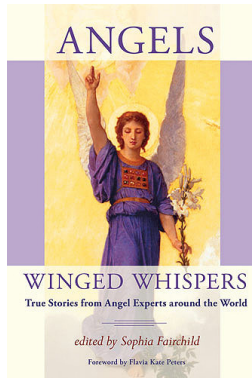




Getting to know the Authors of
